1. Content-All Programmes

Off-site excursions may occur depending on the programme budget and the needs of the participants in the programme. Programme planning is the responsibility of the management team. Planning will consider budget guidelines for excursion, materials, and equipment spending. Staff will be encouraged to contribute ideas and give feedback on each programme. The programme will be structured in such a way as to ensure:

- Participants feel safe, receive care, attention, and support from staff
- Participants are treated fairly, with dignity and respect
- Opportunities are provided for participants to play and enjoy themselves
